# Cure4Kids

Cure4Kids is a comprehensive educational program dedicated to supporting the care of children with cancer and other catastrophic diseases by providing high-quality educational materials and online collaboration tools. Developed by International Outreach Program at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, the Cure4Kids web site ([www.Cure4Kids.org](http://www.Cure4Kids.org)) provides educational content to more than 27,000 healthcare professionals and the public in 175 countries. Content is presented in the form of online seminars with audio narration; electronic full-text books and journals; and online self-paced courses and interactive case discussions in the Oncopedia section. Content is provided in English, Spanish, Portuguese, Russian, Chinese, and Arabic. The Oncopedia section on Cure4Kids provides interactive online encyclopedia for pediatric hematology/oncology cases. Interactive discussion areas allow Cure4Kids users to discuss the content. All material can be easily downloaded and shared for educational use. Over 4 million educational items have been downloaded since the inception of Cure4Kids in 2002. Registration is available at no cost to users.

Cure4Kids provides specialized areas for groups to hold web-based meetings with audio, share documents, and discuss the clinical treatment of children with cancer. Over 300 regional and international groups meet regularly on to discuss difficult cases. Over 100,000 web conferences have been held since 2002 to support clinical education and humanitarian outreach.

The Cure4Kids for Kids section was added to provide public education on cancer and healthy living to children, parents and communities. Children can choose a cartoon character guide, explore a virtual microscope, play games, test their knowledge, and learn about science careers. A separate section is available for parents to reference material related to the topics presented in the children's section so that they can have a source of information to address their children's questions. Teachers from all over the world will be able to access presentations, lesson plans, videos and interact with other educators through a community portal currently under development.
